This exhibition will be on view at PSU's Silver Center for the Arts during the New Hampshire Music Festival in the summer and PSU's Homecoming in the fall. All members are encouraged to submit up to three pieces for consideration.

Juror: Debbie Diston, director of the McIninch Gallery at Southern New Hampshire University. Diston studied at the School of Visual Arts in New York City, St. Martin's School of Art in London, and at Syracuse University in Syracuse, NY. Prior to joining SNHU, she worked at the Danforth Museum of Art and the Concord Art Association. She has extensive experience as a designer and teacher of graphic design.

Insurance: Only work accompanied by a loan form will be insured by PSU while it is on campus. WCA-NH is not responsible for any lost or damaged artwork.

Complete the KDAG Loan Agreement for each work submitted.

Deliver work to be juried and the loan agreement for each piece to the Karl Drerup Art Gallery, Main St., Plymouth (see schedule on the other side). All work must be hand delivered. All jurying will be from actual work only, no slides or digital images.

Commission: PSU will work with both the seller and buyer to facilitate any art sales. PSU receives a 30% commission on any sales.

- Tues., April 30: WCA-NH submission forms due to Edie Weiler.
- Fri., June 20, Noon–4pm or Sat., June 21, 9am–1pm: Artists drop off work to be juried at Karl Drerup Art Gallery, Main Street, Plymouth. KDAG staff will be on hand to receive the work. Each piece delivered must be accompanied by a PSU loan form and be properly labeled.
- June 23: Juror Review.
- June 24: Announcement of accepted and declined art works.
- Fri., June 27, Noon–4pm or Sat., June 28, 9am–1pm: Work not chosen for the show must be picked up.
- June 30: Show installed at PSU's Silver Center for the Arts
- July 2, 6–8pm: Opening Reception
- Sept. 20, 10am–Noon: WCA-NH Fall Meeting, PSU HUB Multipurpose Room. Potluck lunch. Gallery talks. (More information to follow in the newsletter.)
- Oct. 1: Show ends.
- Fri., Oct. 3, Noon–4pm and Sat., Oct. 4, 9am–1pm: Pick up work.

Artist's Commitment:

- Complete ALL paperwork.
- Return application form to Edith Weiler.
- Attach identification label to the back of each artwork you submit.
- **No work will be accepted into the exhibition without correct paperwork.**
- Bring properly labeled **artwork** and the **loan forms** to be juried to KDAG. Jurying will be from actual artwork only. Do not send slides or digital images. **All work must be hand-delivered.**
- Artists will be notified via email or telephone regarding accepted and declined artwork.
- All declined artwork must be picked up on June 27 or 28.
- All accepted artwork must be picked up on October 3 or 4. **Plymouth State University cannot store your artwork—no exceptions. WCA is not responsible for artwork left behind.**
