He has been an arts advocate, gallery director, educator, and professional juror for over 30 years. He has curated shows in Bend, OR; Rochester, NY; Brockport, NY; Ithaca, NY; and Manchester, NH. His articles and reviews have been published in numerous regional newspapers and arts magazines. He has been a teacher and gallery director at the Derryfield School for 15 years. Moerlein holds a BA from Dartmouth College and an MFA from Cornell University. He lives in Bow, NH.

- Artwork must be for sale

Drop Off: Jurying will be done from actual work. Drop off work to be juried at the Performing Arts Auditorium and check in with the WCA/NH representative:
Monday, August 17 (2–4pm)

Jury Date: Monday, August 17 in the evening

Notification: Tuesday, August 18 after 3pm. Notification will be emailed from Andy Moerlein, juror. If you do not have an email address, contact Edith Weiler for assistance.
